ACCESS AND KEYS

We are developing protocols around access and security. The Facilities Team is working through our key system and developing a procedure for levels of access. This will take a week or two. Any BCUC group wanting to use the facilities must book via the office. Please check beforehand whether a room is available. We are not taking any external bookings to hire our facilities until we have finalised the keys, security and other protocols for use of the building.
