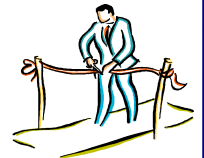

PRAYERS FOR THIS WEEK:


- Pray for Sarah, our new Youth Coordinator as she is introduced to the church and youth group and begins her ministry with us.
