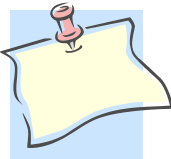

### Thanks To MICK S

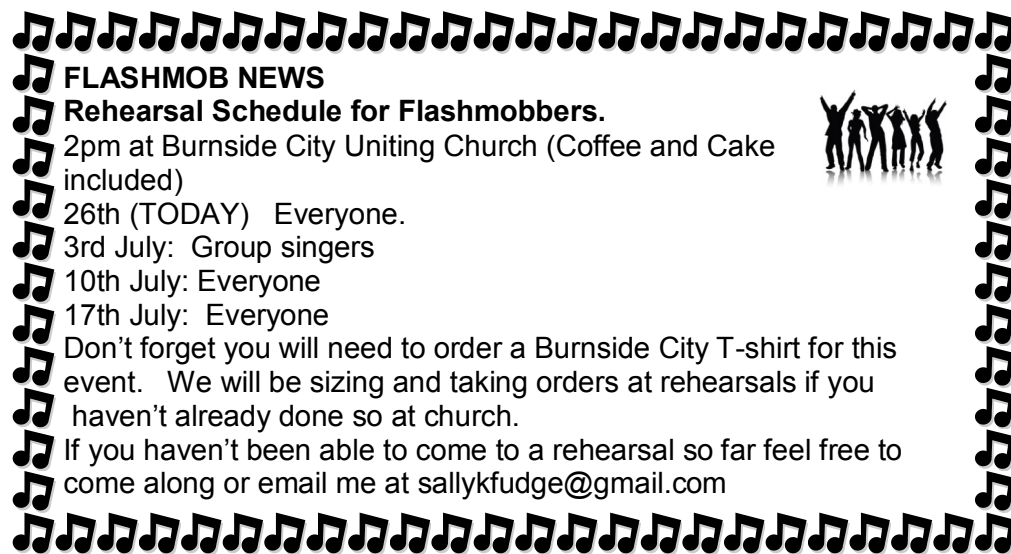
Mick Strapp (9am
