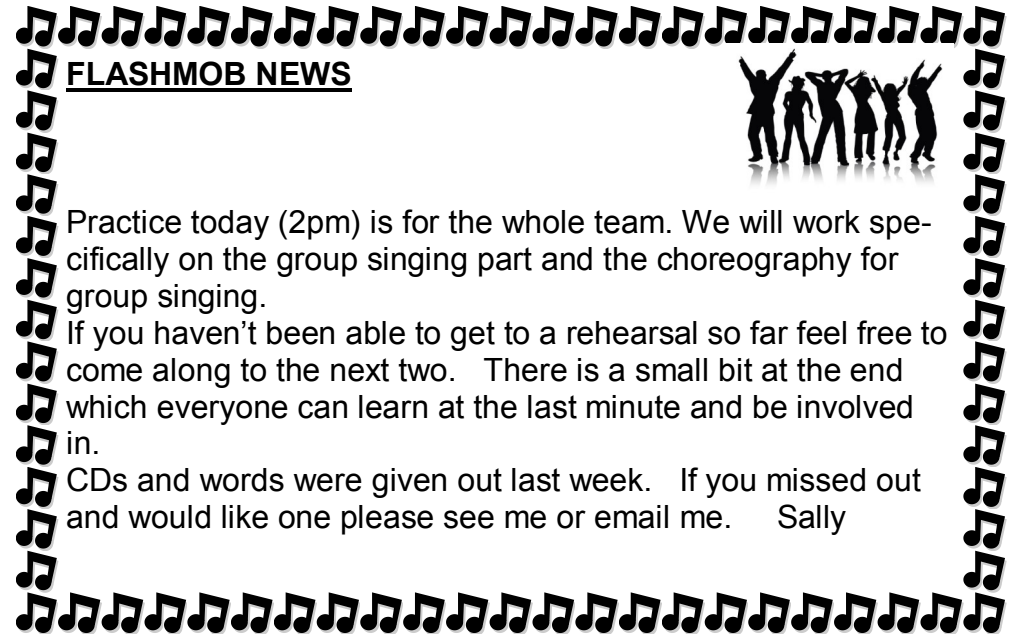


## BCUC T-SHIRTS AND POLO TOPS
